School Computers

Recently I have had to remove a classroom's computers after finding they were not being used correctly.

Our school provides computers for school work only. They are not for Tik Tok Facebook, or for any personal logins or accounts.

Every student signs a contract for the use of these at school and when also at home doing distance learning. They are a privilege not a right and I feel we need to remind all our students of this fact.

I have found some with keys missing and students not too bothered. To supply a school of 50 plus with computers, which we did at the end of 2021, is no mean feat. I do manage to source refurbished computers which help us do so, but they still need to be treated well.

Today the ICT contract is coming back home for parents to read with their children and discuss. Once these are all back, computers will be able to be used in school

Critical Workers

These are workers that are needed to maintain services that support the public like Nurses or education workers to keep a school open. They are people who would be isolated with a household contact who has a positive case of covid.

These workers are tested daily and are separated as much as possible from others except for their work. This is part of Phase 3 of the red light. It allows organisations to still run.

Isolation is now for 7 days. This will allow for the least amount of disruption in school.

Please let me know if you are isolated at home or your child is positive. I have to notify the Ministry of Education every day of our numbers. Auckland cases seem to be trending downwards, Northland upwards

Animals that have enriched my life by Lillian Otway.


