<u>Covid</u>

So far *most* of our cases have been when our students have isolated with family at home.

Isolation is now for 7 days. This will allow for the least amount of disruption in school. Once day 7 has arrived with a negative test they may come back to school. Remember symptoms will hang around, so the negative test is the most important part!

Please let me know if you are isolated at home or if your child is positive. I have to notify the Ministry of Education every day of our numbers. Auckland cases seem to be trending downwards, Northland upwards. They say we will have another peak in May.
