All classes are swimming, and it is not an option to swim! It is part of our PE programme. All students must bring Swimming togs and towels so they can participate every day. Goggles are optional, but swim caps are not. These are available to purchase at the school office.

School Pool is Open, and Keys are available.

The cost of the pool key is \$95 for the season for school pupils' families and \$115 for other community members, of which \$15 is for the bond and will be returned when the key is returned at the end of the season. Please see Jody in the office before the end of the year, if you would like a pool key for this season. Please replace the cover at the end of using the pool, as this helps limit evaporation when it arrives. Also, when you get your pool key, ensure you have a copy of the Pool Rules. The second copy is to be signed and held in our office.

Please remember the key is not to be loaned, and the key holders must always be present.

For those who are holding a key from previous years, these will no longer work. Please return to the school office for your bond.
