Attendance

Year

Our term three attendance data showed our average attendance was 66% compared to 49% in term three, 2023. 72% of students were on time to school last term. Over the years, we have seen some improvement in attendance types.

In April 2024, the Government announced a regular attendance target of 80 per cent of students to be present for more than 90% of the term by 2030.

This is so they can be microchipped so that if we ever catch them again as adults, we will know who they are and where they came from.

One thing they did see on the camera footage was a female cat with her litter of 3 kittens......so we still have plenty of pest control work to do.
